Board meetings are held approximately every two (2) months in the morning. Every board member serves on a committee; depending on the workload, committees meet no more than once a month and often much less frequently. Board members serve one (1) or two (2) three-year terms. Board members are asked to contribute financially according to their capacity, and we ask that during their tenure they make GSWA one of their top two or three charities. We also ask every Board member to engage in the development process at GSWA, for instance by inviting guests to the annual Gala, or by thanking donors, or by helping ask for contributions.
